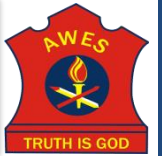

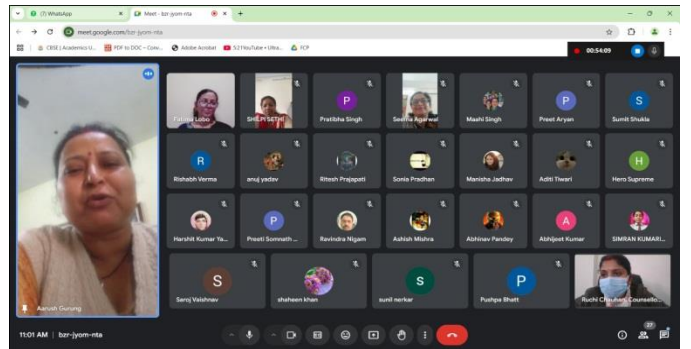
### VIDYANJALI PROGRAMME

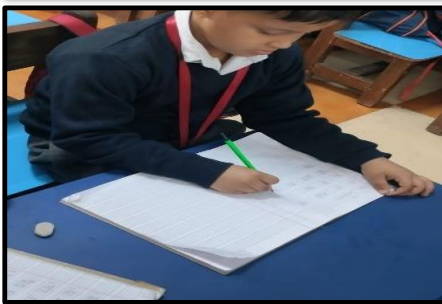
## SHOW AND TELL INTER CLASS COMPETITION
